SITUATION

The Charleston County Transportation Development Department requested qualifications from all interested consulting firms, licensed in the State of South Carolina, experienced in providing engineering services necessary for all items associated with the preparation of traffic studies, preliminary road plans, design and final construction plans for the Savannah Highway Capacity and Intersection Improvements project. The project includes improvements to Savannah Highway within the existing roadway footprint and improving the intersections within the Savannah Highway corridor from Savage Road to Magnolia Road. The services may include, but are not limited to, survey, traffic studies, participation in stakeholder and public meetings, utility coordination including potential conversion of overhead utilities to underground, preparation of preliminary and construction plans, and other related duties as necessary.

Qualifications were received in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 5227-18C for Engineering Design & Permitting for Savannah Highway Capacity and Intersection Improvements.

SITUATION

SBA Towers (SBA Sites LLC), a leader in the tower leasing business in the USA, has requested an extension of the ground lease for the County's Bull Island property, where SBA towers has a communications tower in operation. They have requested that the existing lease that expires in the year 2025 be extended for (2) five year terms, thus ending in 2035. In exchange for this commitment, SBA has offered us a yearly lease payment of \$24,000 (versus \$13,435 in FY18) and an upfront, one-time capital payment to the County of \$25,000.

The reason for this request is at least one of their cellular carrier clients required that leases be valid for at least 15 years in order for them to justify a major capital commitment. This is a general requirement in the communications tower leasing business.

ACTION REQUESTED OF COUNCIL

Authorize the signing of the attached <u>Amendment to Radio Tower Land Lease Agreement</u> to extend the ground lease on our Bull Island property to the year 2035.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the signing of the attached <u>Amendment to Radio Tower Land Lease Agreement</u> for the County's Bull Island property at 6380 Maxville Road, Awendaw SC 29429 with SBA Sites LLC to extend the ground lease an additional ten years to now expire in the year 2035, at a lease rate of \$24,000 per year (plus CPI yearly increases) plus a \$25,000 upfront capital payment.
