Alleghany County Resolution To Establish Fire Service Districts

WHEREAS, pursuant to the County Service District Act of 1973, G.S. §153A-301 through 153A-310 ("the Act"), the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners may define one or more county service districts within which the County may assess taxes to pay for the provision of Fire Protection within the district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. §153A-302, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners held a duly advertised public hearing on , 2020 for the purpose of receiving comments pertaining to the creation of five Fire Service Districts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. §153A-302, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners made a report available for public inspection, including a map of proposed districts and a plan for providing services to the proposed districts; and

WHEREAS, in determining whether to establish the Alleghany County Fire Service Districts, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners has considered the residents and seasonal population and population density of the proposed Districts, the appraised value of property subject to taxation in the proposed Districts, the present tax rates of the County and any municipality in which the Districts or any portion thereof is located, and the ability of the proposed Districts to sustain the additional taxes necessary to provide the services planned for the Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners have held a series of six public meetings, including one in each of the proposed Fire Service Districts, to gather input on the Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The Alleghany County Board of Commissioners does make the following findings based on (i) the report provided to the Board pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §153A-302; (ii) comments made at the public hearing; and (iii) additional evidence and information received by the Board:
 - (a) a demonstrable need for such services exists;
 - (b) it is impossible or impracticable to provide those services on a countywide basis;
 - (c) it is economically feasible to provide those services in the Districts without unreasonable or burdensome annual tax levies; and
 - (d) there is a demonstrable demand for the proposed services by persons residing in the Districts.
- 2. Based on the foregoing findings and in accordance with the Act, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners Board does hereby define the following tax-supported Fire Service Districts for the provision of fire protection services, as depicted in the attached map which is hereby incorporated:
 - Cherry Lane Fire Service District
 - Glade Creek Fire Service District

- Laurel Springs Fire Service District
- Piney Creek Fire Service District
- Sparta Fire Service District

Alleghany County Resolution To Limit Tax Rates on Future Fire Service Districts

WHEREAS, pursuant to the County Service District Act of 1973, N.C.G.S. §153A-301 through 153A-310 ("the Act"), the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners may define one or more county service districts within which the County may assess taxes to pay for the provision of fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners intends to create five Fire Service Districts to provide for fire protection services throughout the County, including the Town of Sparta municipal territory; and

WHEREAS, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners intends to levy an annual property tax within each of the five Fire Service Districts, in addition to the property tax levied throughout the county, to fund fire protection services within the Districts; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. §153A-149 gives counties the authority to levy property taxes up to a combined rate of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) on the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) appraised value of property subject to taxation to fund specific county purposes, including fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners desires to limit the amount of property tax levied in any new Fire Service Districts so as not to place undue financial burden on residents of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners

Upon establishment of any Fire Service Districts by the Alleghany County Board of Commissioners, annual property tax levied within each of the five Fire Service Districts to fund fire protection services within the Districts will not exceed fifteen cents (\$0.15) on the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) appraised value of property subject to taxation.
