III. OLD BUSINESS

a. Second reading and final adoption of an ordinance entitled:

A SERIES BOND ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$10,500,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2020A (WHICH AMOUNT MAY BE INCREASED OR DECREASED BY UP TO \$1,050,000); DESIGNATING THE PAYING AGENT AND REGISTRAR IN RESPECT THEREOF; APPROVING THE PREPARATION OF A PRELIMINARY AND FINAL OFFICIAL STATEMENT IN RESPECT THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF SUCH BONDS TO THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

FISCAL NOTE: A bond ordinance authorizing up to \$10,500,000. Average Annual Debt Service = \$687,736. All-inclusive interest cost = 3.50%. Bond term is for 20 years. Total interest costs = \$3,942,458. The bond also funds a Debt Service Reserve = \$695,540.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, KENTUCKY, ADOPTING AMENDMENT 11 FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND AMENDMENT 10 FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT UNION FOR THE CITY OF ASHLAND, KENTUCKY MEDICAL CARE PLAN AND SUMMARY PLAN ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 46, 2012 AND PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, TO INCLUDE TELEHEALTH SERVICES.

FISCAL NOTE: No additional cost.

IV. CONSENT AGENDA

1. City Manager recommends authorizing the submission of an application to the Tri-State Transit Authority for a Federal Grant under the Section 5310 Program to acquire the 2017 Ford "Wheelchair Lift" mobility minibus originally purchased by Our Lady of Bellefonte Hospital to expand the City's fleet and authorizing Gretchen VanHoose to furnish such additional information as may be required by the Federal Transit Administration or Tri-State Transit Authority in connection with aforesaid application for said grant.

FISCAL NOTE: Estimated cost of insurance, fuel and maintenance annually is \$11,558. FY2021 FTA is 100%.

2. City Manager recommends approving the lay-off of the following positions until such time as revenues may increase allowing a return to work of employees. The Customer Service Representative and the Occupational/Net Profit Tax Clerk may return to work when the City Building re-opens.

City Manager's Office - Administrative Assistant -Community & Economic Development – Receptionist Finance - Payroll Specialist II Finance – Customer Service Representative Finance – Occupational/Net Profit Tax Clerk Parks & Recreation – Maintenance Worker x 2 Public Services (Streets) – Maintenance Worker x 2 Public Services (Central Garage) – Mechanic Utilities (Wastewater Collection) – Operator III Utilities (Sewer Plant) – Operator

FISCAL NOTE: The savings per month for the following positions being laid off:

City Manager's Office - Administrative Assistant - Monthly Savings = \$6,012 or annual savings = \$72,144. Community & Economic Development – Receptionist - Monthly Savings = \$5,131 or annual savings = \$61,572. Finance - Payroll Specialist II - Monthly Savings = \$5,809 or annual savings = \$69,708 Finance – Customer Service Representative X 3 - Monthly Savings = \$13,669 or annual savings = \$164,028. Finance – Occupational/Net Profit Tax Clerk - Monthly Savings = \$3,534 or annual savings = \$42,408. Parks & Recreation – Maintenance Worker x 3 - Monthly Savings = \$13,557 or annual savings = \$162,684. Public Services (Streets) – Maintenance Worker x 2- Monthly Savings = \$9,080 or annual savings = \$108,960. Public Services (Central Garage) – Mechanic - Monthly Savings = \$4,830 or annual savings = \$57,960. Utilities (Wastewater Collection) – Operator III - Monthly Savings = \$5,297 or annual savings = \$63,564 Utilities (Sewer Plant) – Operator - Monthly Savings = \$4,752 or annual savings = \$57,024.

Total Monthly Savings = \$71,671 Total Annualized Savings = \$860,052

3. City Manager recommends the following health plan increases and benefit reductions for all City employees with the exception of Ashland Fire Department union employees. The premium increases and benefit reductions were reviewed and recommended by the Insurance Committee for approval of the Ashland Board of City Commissioners for an approximate savings of \$712,526.88.

Increase employee premiums (Per Pay):

Employee Health Only - From \$25.00 to \$35.00 Employee Health & Dental - From \$27.00 to \$40.78 Employee + 1 Health Only - From \$50.00 to \$65.00 Employee + 1 Health & Dental - From \$54.00 to \$75.54 Family Health Only - From \$70.00 to \$90.00 Family Health & Dental - From \$75.00 to \$103.72

This includes any current employee, hired prior to March 1, 2018 who has a spouse that waives off their employer's plan and onto the City's plan, will increase from \$27.00 per pay to \$35.00 per pay.

Medical Deductible and Out of Pocket (OOP) for In Network and Rx Max OOP increase as follows: Medical Deductible from \$1,000 to \$1,500 individual Medical Deductible from \$2,000 to \$3000 family Medical -Max OOP from \$3000 to \$3,500 individual Medical-Max OOP from \$6000 to \$7000 family

Rx Tier 2 max from \$100 to \$200 for Retail Rx Tier 2 max from \$200 to \$300 for Mail order Rx Tier 3 max from \$150 to \$250 for Retail Rx Tier 3 max from \$200 to \$350 for Mail order Rx OOP max from \$3,100 to \$4,000 Rx OOP max from \$6,200 to \$8,000

FISCAL NOTE: Potential savings of \$712,526.88.

Health Reimbursement Account contribution by City will cease for the calendar year 2021. Current balances will remain until exhausted.

FISCAL NOTE: None.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$175,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF MATCHING LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND ASSISTANCE TO DEVELOP AN INCLUSIVE ADA COMPLIANT PLAYGROUND IN CENTRAL PARK.

FISCAL NOTE: Recreation Fund balance will be a match for this grant. \$350,000 worth of playground equipment for \$ 175,000. Also, applied for an additional grant of approximately \$91,875 for playground flooring.
