Consent

1. Contract amendment with Ice Builders, Inc. for change orders to the Target Center ice replacement project (2018-00389)

Authorizing an increase to Contract No. C-41643 in the amount of \$657,806.17 for a new total of \$3,620,847.02 for necessary change orders due to a design flaw in the Target Center ice replacement project.

2. Request for Proposals (RFP) for Convention Center and Target Center Consulting Pools (2018-00390)

Authorizing the issuance of a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Convention Center and Target Center Consulting Pools for three (3) year contracts running from Jan. 2019 - Dec. 2021.

3. Contract amendment with Egan Company for change orders to the Target Center network installation project (2018-00392)

Authorizing an increase to Contract No. C-41587 in the amount of \$134,110, for a new total of \$900,950, for necessary changes and additional costs for the Target Center network installation project.

4. Lease amendment with Minnesota Department of Transportation (MNDoT) for city use of land under interstate highway 394 bridges (2018-00391)

Authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 21606 extending the lease with MNDoT for City use of land under the interstate highway 394 bridges during 2020-2024, in the amount of \$21,000 per year, for equipment and vehicle storage and for sewer maintenance operations.

5. Gift Acceptance from Clear Channel Outdoor for display time (2018-00399)

Passage of Resolution accepting donation from Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc., for digital billboard space from April 1 - Dec. 31, 2017, to increase awareness of Minneapolis 311, the Talking Is Teaching campaign, sick and safe time ordinance, the Nov. 7 election, the We Are Minneapolis effort, and Snow Emergency parking rules.

6. Bid for Mailing Services (2018-00393)

Accepting the sole bid of Impact Proven Solutions, submitted on Official Publication No. 8495, and authorizing a two (2) year contract in the amount of \$1,000,000 to provide all materials, labor, equipment and incidentals for providing various mailing services, as needed and called for, for the City of Minneapolis - Finance and Property Services Revenue and Collections Department, all in accordance with City specifications.

7. Contract amendment with Riverview Windows, Inc. for lead remediation work: Correction to previous council action (2018-00394)

Amending Council Action 2018A-0081, passed Feb 23, 2018, to correct a mathematical error to increase the revised contract total with Riverview Windows, Inc. from \$2,350,000 to \$2,450,000 for lead remediation services for eligible homes.

- 8. Appointed position in the Human Resources Department: Director Learning and Development Solutions (2018-00333)
 - Adopting findings that the proposed position meets the criteria in Section 20.1010 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, City Council to Establish Positions; and approving the appointed position of Director Learning and Development Solutions, evaluated at 568 total points and allocated to Grade 12.

- 2. Passage of Ordinance amending Title 2, Chapter 20 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Administration: Personnel, approving the salary schedule for the position, which has a salary range of \$104,949 to \$124,410, in accordance with the adopted compensation plan for appointed officials effective Mar. 20, 2018.
- 9. Request for Proposal (RFP) for a Web Content Management System for the City Website project (2018-00380)

Authorizing issuance of a Request for Proposal to provide and implement a new Website Content Management System (WCMS) to manage the City's website and content across numerous city departments.

10. Request for Proposal (RFP) for Community Planning and Economic Development (CPED) Financial Portfolio, Real Estate, and Property Management System (2018-00379)

Authorizing issuance of a Request for Proposal to provide and implement a new system to manage the Office of Community Planning and Economic Development's (CPED) affordable housing and economic development initiatives.

11. Contract with Medical Priority Consultants, Inc. dba Priority Dispatch, for the technology and support of the 911 Call Handling Protocol software system (2018-00377)

Authorizing an increase to Contract No. C-41634 with Medical Priority Consultants, Inc. d/b/a Priority Dispatch in the amount of \$105,000 for a not-to-exceed amount of \$626,695, for enhanced services and training needed for the 911 Call Handling Protocol software system.

12. Contract with Safran (MorphoTrak) for maintenance and support services of the Latent Station (fingerprint system) for the Minneapolis Police Department (MPD) crime laboratory (2018-00378)

Authorizing a contract with Safran (MorphoTrak) for five (5) years in an amount not-to-exceed \$35,000 for maintenance and support services of the Latent Station (fingerprint system) for the

Minneapolis Police Department (MPD) crime laboratory, using the supplier's contract template instead of the City's standard agreement form.

13. Contract with N Harris (dba: Systems & Software, Inc.) for licensing, implementation services, and support, and maintenance of the enQuesta software (2018-00381)

Authorizing an extension to Contract No. C98-12701(A) with N Harris (dba: Systems & Software, Inc.) through Dec. 31, 2023, and adding the City's current terms and conditions to the contract, for licensing, upgrades, implementation services, support, and maintenance of the utility billing system enQuesta.

- 14. Contracts with Minnesota Homeownership Center to provide administration and oversight of homebuyer education and financial wellness services (2018-00356)
 - 1. Authorizing a contract with Minnesota Homeownership Center in an amount not-to-exceed \$175,000, for a period of one year through Dec. 31, 2018, subject to up to two (2) additional one-year extensions by the CPED Director, dependent on availability of funds in future approved City budgets, as follows: \$80,000 for programmatic functions for homebuyer education and detailed homeownership counseling services; and \$95,000 for administration and oversight of homebuyer education and detailed homeownership counseling services.
 - 2. Authorizing a contract with Minnesota Homeownership Center in an amount not-to-exceed \$100,000, for a period of one year through Dec. 31, 2018, subject to up to two (2) additional one-year extensions by the CPED Director dependent on availability of funds in future approved City budgets, as follow: \$85,000 for Financial Wellness programmatic functions; and \$15,000 for Financial Wellness program administration and oversight.
- 15. Contract with Black and Veatch for engineering services for tunneled water main (2018-00288)

Authorizing a contract with Black and Veatch, in an amount not to exceed \$975,000 through Dec 2021, for engineering design and construction services for a new water transmission main crossing the Mississippi River at 10th Ave SE.

16. Bid for gate valve vault repair and replacement (2018-00336)

Accepting the low bid of PCI Roads, LLC, submitted on Official Publication No. 8507, in the amount of \$809,000, to provide all materials, labor, equipment, and incidentals for the construction of the gate valve vault repair and replacement for the City of Minneapolis Public Works Department, and authorizing a contract for the project, all in accordance with City specifications.

17. North and South Sheridan Residential Area Street Resurfacing Project: Postpone levy of assessments (2018-00347)

Amending Resolution 2017R-193 entitled "Ordering the work to proceed and adopting the special assessments for the North and South Sheridan Area Residential Street Resurfacing Project No. 9964E," passed April 28, 2017, to postpone the levy of special assessments until 2018 to begin collection on 2019 real estate tax statements

- 18. Irving Ave N Street Resurfacing: Project approval and assessment (2018-00351)
 - Passage of Resolution ordering the work to proceed and adopting special assessments in the amount of \$133,185.19 for Irving Ave N in the 2018 Street Resurfacing Program, Project No. 2299D (CPV1856).
 - Passage of Resolution requesting the Board of Estimate and Taxation to authorize the City's issuance and sale of assessment bonds in the amount of \$133,185 for the Irving Ave N Street Resurfacing Project.
- 19. Lyndale Ave N Street Resurfacing: Project approval and assessment (2018-00352)

- Passage of Resolution ordering the work to proceed and adopting special assessments in the amount of \$497,903.49 for Lyndale Ave N in the 2018 Street Resurfacing Program, Project No 2299E (CPV1856).

 - 1. Passage of Resolution accepting gifts from Green Minneapolis for revitalization of Peavey Plaza.
 - 2. Passage of Resolution increasing the appropriation for the Public Works Department by \$851,000.
- 26. Bid for Peavey Plaza Rehabilitation Project (2018-00370)

Accepting the low bid of Global Specialty Contractors, Inc., submitted on Official Publication No. 8524, in the amount of \$7,210,577, to provide all materials, labor equipment and incidentals for the construction of the Peavey Plaza Rehabilitation Project for the City of Minneapolis Public Works Department, and authorizing a contract for the project, all in accordance with City specifications.

27. Bid for cleaning of the large diameter sanitary sewer system (2018-00368)

Accepting the low bid of Diversified Infrastructure Services, Inc., submitted on Official Publication No. 8514, in the amount of \$303,990.05, to provide all materials, labor, equipment and

incidentals for the cleaning of the large diameter sanitary sewer system for the City of Minneapolis Public Works Department, and authorizing a contract for the project, all in accordance with City specifications.

- 28. Bid for hauling and disposal of agricultural liming material (2018-00369)

 Accepting the low bid of Huls Bros. Trucking, submitted on Official Publication No. 8506, for an estimated annual expenditure of \$2,000,000, to provide all materials, labor, equipment and incidentals necessary for the hauling and disposal of agricultural liming material for the City of Minneapolis Public Works

 Department Water Treatment and Distribution Division, and authorizing a contract from April 1, 2018, through March 31, 2019, with an option to extend for two additional calendar years through March 31, 2021, at the sole discretion of the City, all in accordance with City specifications.
- 29. Bid for Ready Mix Concrete (2018-00385)

Accepting the low bid of AVR, Inc., submitted on Official Publication No. 8533, in the amount of \$1,361,137.50, to produce and deliver Ready Mix Concrete as needed for various locations in the City of Minneapolis from April 1, 2018, to March 31, 2019, all in accordance with City specifications. Contract value will be established at \$1,514,787.50 to include additional items from the low bidder as specified in their bid response and as required by the City. Bidder offers to increase quantities by up to 100% during the contract term.

30. Bid for Bituminous Mixtures (2018-00387)

Accepting the low bid of Tiller Corporation doing business as Commercial Asphalt Company, submitted on Official Publication No. 8530, in the amount of \$4,665,700, to produce and deliver Bituminous Mixtures as needed to various locations in the City of Minneapolis from April 1, 2018, through March 31, 2019, all in accordance with City specifications. Bidder offers to increase quantities by up to100% during the contract term.
