This is a request by Brian Underwood of The Planning Center, on behalf of the property owners, 4-D Properties, LLC, to rezone approximately 23 acres from R-1, MH-1, and C-2 to OCR-1 zoning. The rezoning site is located east of Kina Parkway, south of Kino Sports Complex between Benson Highway and the Julian Wash, approximately one-half mile south of Interstate 10. The preliminary development plan (PDP) proposes a mixed-use activity center with a sports and tourism focus including retail, restaurants, entertainment, and hospitality.

The Zoning Examiner and Staff recommend approval of OCR-1 zoning.

Land use policy direction for this area is provided by the Kino Area Plan (KAP) and Plan Tucson (PT).

Eight (8) written approvals and zero (0) written protests were received prior to the Zoning Examiner's public hearing on June 30, 2020, at that time requiring a simple majority vote of Mayor and Council to adopt a rezoning ordinance.
