1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

Roll called, quorum met.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT

3. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

3.01. Review and approval of minutes.

Minutes of December 1, 2016, February 9, 16 and 23, 2017 were moved for approval by Chair Sally Wooden, second by Jasmine Leek. Unanimously approved.

3.02. Review of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications and make contingency recommendations for prioritization of 2017-2018 funding allocations.

HUD has mandated the City to submit a contingency recommendation for fund allocations in anticipation of probable cuts to the 2017-2018 CDBG funds. Staff recommended shifting allocations by either percentage cuts or ranking services by priority. Staff reported that projects of three (3) sub-recipients are not scalable, wherein the project cannot proceed without the

full recommended funding. These are Salvation Army, Stockton Shelter for the Homeless and Gospel Center Rescue Mission.

Chair Sally Wooden commented that a ten to fifteen percent reduction across the board would probably still allow the services to operate, however, anything higher would make some services non-attainable. Randy Burns suggested that if the projects that are at the lowest priority are removed from consideration, all the others can be funded. Jasmine Leek suggested ranking the services by priority before making further recommendations. Ranking are as follows: Priority 1: Emergency Food Bank, Second Harvest, Meals on Wheels. Priority 2: Gospel Center Rescue Mission. Priority 3: DRAIL, Salvation Army. Priority 4: Read To Me Stockton, Tuleburg Press. Priority 5: Stockton Shelter.

After further discussion, Committee recommends the following:

1. Reductions be based on priority
2. No funding less than \$10,000
3. Fair Housing cuts will depend on staff recommendations.

Recommendation moved for approval by Randy Burns, second by James Gorman.

4. ADJOURNMENT
