Nepotism Policy of Fayette County

Nepotism generally refers to favoritism and partiality granted to Relatives in the hiring, promotion, disciplinary, and firing process. In the context of this policy, certain practices shall be prohibited and considered Nepotism.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

Public confidence in County government requires openness and transparency in all functions. Concentration of any function of government in any family erodes this public confidence. Nepotism creates the appearance of impropriety, whether or not any actual improper activities exist or have occurred, affecting the County's ability to operate effectively and without hinderances. Potential personal conflicts from outside of the work environment that carry over to day-to-day working relationships can also result from Nepotism.

DEFINITIONS:

RELATIVE: The term "RELATIVE" means father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, husband, wife, son, daughter, step-son, step-daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, niece or nephew (by blood or marriage). Relatives by adoption are treated the same as biological relatives.

COMMISSIONER: Any person elected or appointed County Commissioner.

DEPARTMENT HEAD: Any person supervising a department of Fayette County under the management of the Commissioner's office.

PROHIBITIONS:

It shall be the policy of Fayette County to exclude from employment any relative of a Commissioner, with the exception of such employment predating the election of the Commissioner.

It shall be the policy of Fayette County to prohibit from employing any relative of a Department Head in the department or office over which the Department Head supervises.

It shall be the policy of Fayette County that no person be employed, considered for employment, or promoted into a position where such employment would be under the direct supervision of a relative.

It shall be the policy of Fayette County that no person be employed, considered for employment, or promoted into a position where such employment would make the person a direct supervisor of a relative.

It shall be the policy of Fayette County to not allow a person to take part in actions concerning hiring, disciplining, promoting, or dismissing a relative.

It shall be the policy of Fayette County that no person be employed, considered for employment, or promoted into a position where such employment would be in a department or closely related department that a Relative is already employed in.

EXCEPTIONS:

Nothing in this policy shall pertain to any current employee as of the date of this policy.

In the event this policy is contrary to any existing contract, collective bargaining agreement, or statutory right of an employee, such agreement or right shall be controlling.

This policy does not apply to non-compensated voluntary activities.
