Sumter Development Board Building Grand Opening

Scheduled to take place Thursday, March 15, 2018 from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The new Sumter Development Board building along with the property located adjacent to the Rotary Centennial Plaza will be deemed the site of the event with alcoholic beverages restricted to that area.

Sumter Green Untapped Food Truck Festival

Scheduled to take place on Saturday, March 3, 2018 from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at and around the Farmers Market Building at the Fair Grounds.

Fourth Fridays on Main Concert Series

Scheduled to take place from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Main Street on the following dates (fourth Friday of the month):

United Way Downtown Derby Day

Scheduled to take place on Saturday, May 5, 2018, from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Main Street between Liberty Street and Hampton Avenue, as well as the City Centre Terrace. All of the proceeds from Derby Day Sumter will go to the United Way of Sumter, Clarendon and Lee Counties in their efforts to support the needs of the community in the areas of education, income (basic needs) and health.

Downtown Microbrew Festival (Sumter Senior Services)

Scheduled to take place on Friday, May 11, 2018 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The Rotary Centennial Plaza will be deemed the site of the food garden. Beer tastings will take place inside various businesses in the Central Business District; outdoor alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to the tastings at the businesses and the food garden area. All proceeds will benefit Senior Programs in Sumter County.

Taste at the Gardens/Iris Festival

Scheduled to take place on Thursday, May 24, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at Swan Lake Iris Gardens.

Sumter Green Fall Feast

Scheduled to take place on Thursday, September 20, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Nettles Building Auditorium at USC-Sumter.

Downtown OktoberFest

Scheduled to take place Saturday, September 22, 2018 from 5:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. The area of Main Street, from Liberty Street to Hampton Street, and the area of Hampton Street from Main Street to the entrance of the Hampton Street Parking Lot, will be deemed the site of the public festival and will be closed to traffic, with alcoholic beverages restricted to that area. Proceeds benefit the Sumter United Ministries.

Porches of Sumter

Scheduled to take place Thursday, October 4, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. at Sumter's Memorial Park and specified homes in the area of the park. Tickets will be sold by the Chamber of Commerce for the event and various foods will be served on the porches at ten different homes that border Memorial Park. A band will perform at the park and beer and wine will be served in a designated area of the park to those purchasing tickets. The areas where alcohol consumption is permitted shall be limited to the specified porches and the designated area of Memorial Park.

Sumter Downtown Market

Scheduled to take place every Saturday from May 2018 through September 2018 from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The Rotary Centennial Plaza and property located adjacent will be deemed the site of the market. Some vendors would like the opportunity to serve patrons a light morning beverage.

Downtown Zombie Fest Halloween Event

Scheduled to take place Saturday, October 27, 2018 from 5:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. The area of Main Street, from Liberty Street to Hampton Street will be deemed the site of the public festival and will be closed to traffic, with alcoholic beverages restricted to that area. Proceeds to benefit the Young Professionals of Sumter and their community service projects.

Sip & Stroll (Sumter Senior Services)

Scheduled to take place on Friday, November 2, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The area of Main Street, from Caldwell Street to Law Range, will be deemed the site of the public festival, however, alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to inside the participating businesses and the Rotary Centennial Plaza. Proceeds benefit Senior Programs in Sumter County.

- WHEREAS, during these times, all pets shall be prohibited on the designated premises, as well as coolers, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups; and
- WHEREAS, during the above-mentioned events, the specified locations will be deemed to be a site of public festival at which alcoholic beverages (beer and wine only) shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the designated areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the members of Sumter City Council, do hereby authorize and support the events described above.
