A RESOLUTION

APPROVING THE ACQUISITION OF A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT BY THE CITY OF SUMTER, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN CONNECTION WITH THE TOWN OF MAYESVILLE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT CONNECTION PROJECT

- whereas, the City of Sumter, South Carolina (the "City") is required to obtain temporary construction easements from the property owners listed in Exhibit "A" hereto to connect the Town of Mayesville Waste Water Treatment System to the City of Sumter's sewer system; the Wastewater Connection Project is known as Mayesville Waste Water Treatment Plant Connection to the City of Sumter Waste Water System (the "Project"); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Mayesville wastewater treatment plant provides sewer service to a low-to-moderate income area in the Town of Mayesville;
- **WHEREAS**, the City, through a valuation process, has determined just compensation to be paid for the temporary construction easements to the affected property owners as set forth in Exhibit "A";
- WHEREAS, applicable federal and state laws and regulations require that just compensation be reviewed and established by the public agency acquiring the temporary easement as part of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project; and
- WHEREAS, this action complies with the "Final Government-Wide Rule Implementing Changes to the Uniform Relocation Act" (Public Law 100-17), State Law and Grants Administration Policies and Procedures;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

- 1. The City Council of the City (the "Council") hereby establishes just compensation for the temporary construction easements to be acquired by the City of Sumter as set forth on Exhibit "A" in connection with the Project.
- 2. The Council finds and determines that the Project will serve a low-to-moderate income area.
- 3. The Council approves the acquisition of the temporary construction easements for prices of not less than the determined just compensation.
- 4. This approval is based on the statement of just compensation and the uncomplicated value of the property.






