

**RESOLUTION NO. 749**

**A RESOLUTION COMMITTING THE CITY OF SUMTER  
TO PROVIDING A LOCAL MATCH FOR A MUNICIPAL ASSOCIATION  
OF SOUTH CAROLINA HOMETOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT  
AND FOLLOWING ITS PROCUREMENT POLICY WHEN SECURING  
SERVICES AND PRODUCTS WITH GRANT FUNDS**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMTER**, here assembled on this 18 day of September 2018, that the City Council hereby commits to provide a local cash-in-kind match of at least \$25,000, which equals the minimum 50-percent local match required by the Municipal Association of South Carolina, to support the City of Sumter application for a \$25,000 Hometown Economic Development Grant. These grant and local matching funds will be used for the City of Sumter's Science of Success for Teens program. This hands-on program is designed to provide youth with an environment for leadership and social skill values to be introduced, practiced, and shared.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council will follow its procurement policy adopted in accordance with SC Code of Laws Section 11-35-50 when securing all services and products purchased with funds awarded from a Hometown Economic Development Grant.

This resolution is made in regard to the submission of an application for Hometown Economic Development Grant funds to the Municipal Association of South Carolina on or before September 28, 2018.
