



C. Mayor Horton recognized Director of Engineering, Mark Waller, who presented Council with information concerning the upcoming sediment plate study at the Lake Murray Water Plant. He stated the study had deadlines that the City needed to meet in order to include the summer and winter months of this year. He stated this study would take nine months of testing. He said he would present Council with more information at the May 1st meeting.



SUBJ: CONSIDERATION OF ACCOMMODATIONS TAX COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The West Columbia Accommodations Tax Committee met on Tuesday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, to consider the seven qualified applications for the distribution of Accommodation Tax Funds (65% Tourism Related Funds). This year we had an increase of \$20,000 in funds over last year, bringing the total available funds to \$64,000. While this is great news, the requests made this year also increased to a total of \$90,000.

After reviewing the submitted applications and hearing comments by those applicants present, the Committee unanimously approved to recommend funding the following applicants in the amounts listed:
