Town Creek Culvert Drainage Improvement Project Update and 8th Street Outfall Change Order

Explanation:

Abstract: The 8th Street Stormwater Outfall drains approximately 20 acres of the Arts District. The Engineering Department will present information on the need for the removal and replacement of this outfall and discuss a change order to the Town Creek Culvert Drainage Improvement Project contracts.

Explanation: The 8th Street Stormwater Outfall drains approximately 20 acres of the Arts District. This outfall was investigated by the Engineering Department as a result of research for the Dickinson Avenue Modernization Project being completed by the North Carolina Department of Transportation (U-5606). The video of the culvert revealed the current outfall was in poor condition. Several locations had been repaired, and severe longitudinal cracking and utility conflicts were also noted. In addition, as a result of increased development west of Dickinson Avenue, this outfall is under sized and cannot convey the design storm.

The Engineering Department will present information on the need for the removal and replacement of this outfall and discuss the potential for a change order to the Town Creek Culvert Drainage Improvement Project contracts.

Fiscal Note: Funding for these change orders will be provided by the Stormwater Utility.
